

## ***Alfa Romeo East Coast Challenge 2009***

Alfa Romeo racing cars running in their own category will make their first appearance on the revamped Lakeside Park circuit when round three of the *Queensland Racing Drivers Series* fires into action on the weekend of July 3-5/ 2009.

With several million dollars having been poured into the rejuvenation of the legendary Lakeside track and its surrounds, Alfa Romeo racing drivers from all over Australia are invited to test their skills on one of the most exhilarating race circuits in Australia. Now all Alfa Romeo drivers will have their chance on a track that has been resurfaced and widened with the entries and exits of several corners slightly altered for improved safety.

This annual event, being run in Queensland this year, is the perfect opportunity to match you and your cars potential with other Alfa Romeo owners in a battle to win the protégées East Challenge Cup.

As part of the planning for this event we would like to bring to your attention some of details that are now in place.

- There will be a maximum entry list of 40 cars. This is due to the track density rules. Please get your entry in early.
- Entry fee for the weekend, will be \$249.00. This is based on entries received prior to June 25/2009. Entries that are received after this date will be \$349.00.
- All competitors that are accepted for the event will receive an allocated covered pit position.
- Practise time is available on Friday, July 3/09. Cost for the practise day will be an additional \$ for those who wish to participate.
- Camping is available if competitors wish to stay at the track. Hot showers and toilet facilities are centrally located to the camp sites. Cost for camping is \$20.00 per night

- All drivers competing in this event will need an AASA national licence. If you do not have a licence, Queensland Raceways has agreed to make available AASA national license for use over the weekend for a price of \$60.00. This is to cover the cost of your personal insurance.
- For people looking for motel rooms, we have made contact with Kallangur Motel and they are offering 2-3 star accommodation. The motel is approximately 8 minutes drive from the track. The price per room per night is \$90.00. including breakfast. The rooms will accommodate 2 to 3 people depending on the room layout. There are only 17 units in the motel, so early bookings are recommended. The motel is situated next to the Kallangur Tavern, so there is an easy transit, through the parking lot, from the bar to the motel. The motel is located close to all the normal fast food outlets. - A Shell service station is located approximately 5Kms from the track on Anzac Ave, Kallangur, if high octane pump fuel is required. For those requiring racing fuel, it can be ordered from Queensland Raceway at least a week prior to the event and it will be delivered to Lakeside Park.
